## In 2020 the VSO supported 37 projects in 20 countries with \$944,705 USD.

### PROJECT TYPES:

Administration: projects directly supporting the Vincentian priests and

brothers in the missions Dollars Spent: \$32,562

Religious Formation: projects for the initial or ongoing training of priests

and/or brothers

Dollars Spent: \$240,168.

Pastoral Projects: projects supporting the laity's religious instruction,

spiritual growth and worship Dollars Spent: \$248,841.

Socioeconomic Projects: projects supporting the material needs and development of people and communities





In all, with the help of our supporters and collaborators:

- We were able to help 5 provinces with transportation needs that included 2 pick-up trucks, 2 small buses and a boat
- We helped with the furnishings or construction projects at 11 schools
- We helped 1 parish furnish its presbytery
- Three projects helped residents with either better quality or quantities of water
- Several parishes were helped with their revenue generating projects
- Five seminaries were aided with either furnishings or building renovations
- We completed projects in 20 countries: 19 in Africa, 6 in Asia, 8 in Latin America and 1 in the South Pacific.
